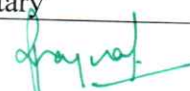
Subject: Constitution of Herbal Garden Committee for the Academic Session 2026–27

Functions of the Herbal Garden Committee

The Committee shall:

- Develop, maintain and enrich the Herbal Garden with medicinal and aromatic plant species prescribed under the PCI curriculum and other indigenous medicinal plants.
- Ensure proper identification, scientific nomenclature, labelling and documentation of medicinal plants maintained in the Herbal Garden.
- Support practical teaching, research, field demonstrations and project work related to Pharmacognosy and medicinal plant sciences.
- Promote conservation of medicinal plants, biodiversity and environmental sustainability through awareness programmes, plantation drives and Green Campus initiatives.
- Maintain records of plant inventory, plantation activities, maintenance schedules and survival status of medicinal plants.
- Coordinate with the Green Campus Committee, Waste Management Committee, Environmental Committee and IQAC for sustainable campus development.
- Organize workshops, exhibitions, herbal awareness programmes and observance of important environmental days.
- Prepare annual development plans and submit periodic reports, Minutes of Meetings and Action Taken Reports to the Director.
- The Committee shall meet at least once every semester or more frequently as required to review the maintenance and development of the Herbal Garden.

This Order shall come into force with immediate effect and shall remain valid for the Academic Session 2026-27 or until further orders.
