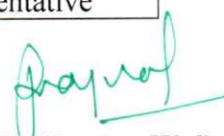
OFFICE ORDER

Subject: Constitution of Waste Management Committee for the Academic Session 2026–27

Functions of the Committee

The Committee shall:

- Ensure compliance with CPCB guidelines and all applicable environmental and waste management regulations.
- Develop and implement a comprehensive waste management system covering solid waste, laboratory chemical waste, biomedical waste (where applicable), hazardous waste, plastic waste, glass waste and e-waste.
- Promote segregation of waste at source using colour-coded bins and approved disposal practices.
- Monitor collection, storage, transportation and disposal of laboratory chemicals and hazardous materials through authorised agencies.
- Coordinate with authorised recyclers and waste treatment facilities for disposal of biomedical, hazardous and electronic waste.
- Conduct periodic inspections of laboratories, stores, hostels, canteen and other campus facilities to ensure proper waste handling and sanitation.
- Organize awareness programmes on waste minimization, recycling, environmental protection and sustainable campus practices for students and employees.
- Maintain records relating to waste generation, disposal, vendor authorisations, manifests, inspections and statutory compliance.
- Recommend measures for reducing waste generation, improving resource efficiency and promoting green campus initiatives.
- Submit periodic reports and recommendations to the Director and IQAC for continuous improvement.
- The Committee shall meet at least once every quarter and whenever required. Minutes of Meetings, inspection reports and Action Taken Reports shall be maintained by the Member Secretary.

This Order shall come into force with immediate effect and shall remain valid for the Academic Session 2026–27 or until further orders.
