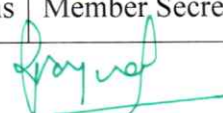
Subject: Constitution of Question Paper Screening Committee for Internal Examinations

- Ensure adequate coverage of all units with an appropriate balance of easy, moderate and difficult questions.
- Eliminate typographical, factual and technical errors before printing.
- Maintain strict confidentiality in the preparation, moderation, printing and custody of question papers.
- Recommend improvements in question paper quality based on examination analysis and academic feedback.
- Maintain records of moderation proceedings and submit reports to the Head of Institution whenever required.
- The Committee shall meet prior to every internal examination or whenever required. The proceedings of the Committee and all question papers shall be treated as Strictly Confidential.

This Order shall come into force with immediate effect and shall remain valid for the Academic Session 2026-27 or until further orders.
