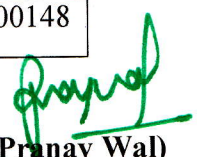

OFFICE ORDER**Subject: Constitution of Students' Grievance Redressal Committee (SGRC) for the Academic Session 2026–27**

In pursuance of the University Grants Commission (Redressal of Grievances of Students) Regulations, 2023, the guidelines of the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), and the provisions of Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Technical University (AKTU), Lucknow, the following Students' Grievance Redressal Committee (SGRC) is hereby constituted for the Academic Session 2026–27 to ensure prompt, fair, transparent, and effective redressal of grievances of students.

The Committee shall consider grievances relating to academic matters, examination, attendance, scholarships, training and placement, hostel, library, laboratory, student services, administrative issues, and any other matter affecting the academic and campus life of students, except matters falling within the jurisdiction of the Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) and the Anti-Ragging Committee.

Functions of the Committee

The Committee shall:

- Receive, examine and redress grievances submitted by students in a fair, impartial and time-bound manner.
- Provide an opportunity of hearing to the concerned parties before arriving at any decision.
- Ensure confidentiality and protect students against victimization or retaliation.
- Maintain a register of grievances, proceedings, recommendations and action taken.
- Recommend corrective and preventive measures for improvement of institutional processes.
- Refer cases relating to sexual harassment, ragging, discrimination or criminal misconduct to the appropriate statutory committee/authority.
- Submit periodic reports on grievances received and their disposal to the Director.
- Students may submit their grievances in writing or through the prescribed online/offline grievance redressal mechanism available in the Institute. Every effort shall be made to resolve grievances within the time prescribed under the applicable regulations.

This Order shall come into force with immediate effect and shall remain valid for the Academic Session 2026-27, unless modified or superseded by subsequent orders.
